



SBWC Church History



First Baptist Church of Silver Springs Shores, initially known as "Shores Baptist Chapel," was established in 1975 as a mission sponsored by the Marion Baptist Convention. In February 1978, it transitioned to become a mission of the First Baptist Church of Ocala.

The inaugural worship service took place on January 19, 1975, at the Mid-State Federal building, located at the corner of Highway 464 and Water Road. Sixteen people attended the service, which was led by Pastor Clyde Harless, the Associational Missions Director for the Marion Baptist Association. Between 1978 and 1987, the church experienced rapid growth in both attendance and contributions. This period of expansion led to the appointment of four pastors and underscored the need for a new sanctuary. In 1987, First Baptist Church of Silver Springs appointed Arthur Hoff as pastor. By 1997, plans for a new sanctuary were finalized, and the "Challenge to Build" fundraising program was launched.

In 1995, under the leadership of Pastor Arthur Hoff, the congregation began researching and adopting plans for a new sanctuary.

The congregation officially voted to construct a building that would include a sanctuary, a conference and rehearsal room, and two offices. On October 26, 1997, following the morning worship service, the groundbreaking ceremony for the new sanctuary was held. The event was attended by 150 members and friends. Sister Pamela Halsey led the congregation in song. The "Challenge to Build" fundraising program concluded successfully with a banquet, totalling pledges of \$147,314 over three years. Construction of the new sanctuary began in November 1997 and was completed by October 25, 1998.

SBWC Church History

In the years that followed, several significant changes took place. In October 2003, the church adopted a new mission statement: "*People reaching people through the power of God's love*" and changed its name to Shores Baptist Worship Center.

In December 2004, Pastor Arthur Hoff resigned after seventeen years of dedicated service to the church and the Silver Springs Shores community.

In the subsequent months, Deacon Sylvester Denton maintained the church with pulpit supply from Marion Baptist Association.

Eventually, the congregation selected and organized a pastor search committee.




Unearthing the past

After careful deliberation, in August 2005, Minister Harold N. Garner, Jr., from New St. John Missionary Baptist Church of Ocala, was selected to fill the pastoral position at Shores Baptist Worship Center.

On September 24, 2005, Reverend Harold N. Garner, Jr., was installed as the new pastor of Shores Baptist Worship Center and is currently serving the church and the community of Silver Spring Shores in that capacity. Trust the Holy Spirit to move in power as you disciple the congregation through faithful preaching. "Preach the word! Be ready in season and out. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching." ~ 2 Timothy 4:2 ~

Throughout the years, SBWC has glorified God through music and song, a cherished part of our worship. Since the church's founding, many individuals have contributed to this ministry by sharing their talents, donating instruments, and providing generous support.

In its early days, the church's music program grew with donated instruments, starting with a memorial piano and a small parlor organ loaned by Adele Danielsen, the pastor's wife.

A used Gulbransen theater organ from Summerfield Baptist Church followed but was later passed on to another congregation.

Members then fundraised to purchase an Italian-made Gem classical organ, while a Baldwin theater-style organ was added for its distinctive sound.

Over time, these instruments wore out, and in the late 1990s, new donations came in, including keyboards from Monique Craig and Herbert Leist, a Baldwin church organ from Charles and Eulie Judge and an organ from Charlotte Smith.

Eventually, advancing technology and a shift to contemporary worship led to the replacement of organs with modern soundtracks and an anointed praise team.

The Pandemic Era 2020

The COVID-19 pandemic posed significant challenges to churches worldwide, changing how congregations worshiped, served, and stayed connected. While many churches were forced to close due to social distancing and lockdown measures, SBWC was blessed to remain active.

In the fall of 2019, the media department was expanded to feature a new interactive website, a stronger social media presence, video announcements, and streaming services. This preparation allowed SBWC to adapt seamlessly, offering in-person services and online services, online Bible study, food distribution, and even outdoor drive-in services on the church grounds. Dedicated leaders, teachers, and servants worked faithfully to continue serving the congregation and the community throughout this challenging time.
